Please read more below about the safety measures we are taking and the protocols you can expect while working on the construction site. We look forward to seeing you and thank you for your support!

WHEN YOU ARRIVE FOR YOUR VOLUNTEER SHIFT:

- Please have your cloth mask as it is required at all times while you are on site. Please bring multiple masks in case yours get dirty or sweaty during the course of the day
- A member of staff will ask you a few questions to ensure you are feeling well and not showing symptoms

CLEANING & HAND WASHING

- Please be sure to regularly wash or sanitize your hands – there will be extra hand washing stations available
- If you leave the site during your shift, please wash or sanitize your hands on re-entry
- Please bring your own work gloves and eye protection if you have them
- Tools will not be shared and will be sanitized at the end of the day
- High touch surfaces will be cleaned and sanitized regularly throughout the day

SOCIAL DISTANCING

- Everyone on site will be practicing social distancing of at least 6 feet
- HSGF staff will help minimize interactions and maintain social distancing
- Unfortunately, breaks and lunches cannot be taken as groups – and may be staggered to help maintain social distancing

LUNCH & WATER

- Please bring your own bagged lunch
- Since communal water has been discontinued, HGSF will have single-serve water bottles available. We also ask that you bring your own water bottle and extra water for the day
- Please do not share any food or drinks
