

Thank you so much for your interest in volunteering for Habitat for Humanity Greater San Francisco! The safety and well-being of volunteers, colleagues and partners is our highest priority. Please read more below about the safety measures we are taking and the protocols you can expect while working on the construction site. We look forward to seeing you and thank you for your support!

WHEN YOU ARRIVE FOR YOUR VOLUNTEER SHIFT:

- **Covid Screening Questions:** Please be aware that upon entering the site, you will be asked questions to screen for risk of exposure. Note that if in the last 14 days, you have tested positive, are awaiting results, experiencing or exposed to symptoms, exposed to someone with Covid or gathered indoors without a mask with people outside of your household, you will be declined entry to the site.
- Please have your cloth mask as it is required at all times while you are on site. Please bring multiple masks in case yours get dirty or sweaty during the course of the day

CONTACT TRACING

- Attendance is recorded strictly at the site to help facilitate contact tracing. Volunteers must report to Habitat staff if they experience Covid-19 symptoms or receive a positive diagnosis within 2 weeks of their volunteer day. Reports will be shared with others who worked on that day but sources will remain anonymous.

CLEANING & HAND WASHING

- Please be sure to regularly wash or sanitize your hands – there will be extra hand washing stations available
- If you leave the site during your shift, please wash or sanitize your hands on re-entry
- Please bring your own work gloves and eye protection if you have them
- Tools will not be shared and will be sanitized at the end of the day
- High touch surfaces will be cleaned and sanitized regularly throughout the day

SOCIAL DISTANCING

- Everyone on site will be practicing social distancing of at least 6 feet
- HSGF staff will help minimize interactions and maintain social distancing
- Unfortunately, breaks and lunches cannot be taken as groups – and may be staggered to help maintain social distancing

LUNCH & WATER

- Please bring your own bagged lunch
- Since communal water has been discontinued, HSGF will have single-serve water bottles available. We also ask that you bring your own water bottle and extra water for the day
- Please do not share any food or drinks
